

Colorado Teen, 16, Shot and Killed Overnight in Aurora: Community Seeks Answers After Tragic Shooting

A 16-year-old teen was shot and killed overnight in Aurora, Colorado, marking another tragic incident of youth gun violence that has deeply affected the local community. The fatal shooting occurred during late-night hours, prompting an immediate response from law enforcement and emergency personnel.
